DISCUSSION:

Mrs. Orban Brown wanted the entire sentence of the last paragraph deleted from the "MTBOE Draft Standards" based on the following four reasons. 1) The sentence uses the word "ensure," and our Board cannot ensure how others feel or prosper. 2) Because of reason #1, the success or failure of the thought behind that sentence cannot be measured; thus the Board can never determine whether it has met the standard. 3) The sentence is written in such a broad way that it could set up unrealistic expectations. 4) Use of the word "authentically" opens the door to misinterpretation by those who would challenge the schools' authority.

Mr. Christmann - Misconstrued social issues - hot button - we have avoided them as vigorous discussion items, I want to have an environment where you can be yourself and wear your

clothing, and announce yourself to the world. If we are not on board with that, I can table it, etc. Don't hide from the concept, etc.

Dr. Mandel - I do not understand the issue with "authentic", what is it exactly? I am here to represent everyone, the students, the staff, and the community.

Mrs. Orban Brown - I also represent the staff, community, etc. Others don't agree or feel the way we do.

Mr. Christmann moved to approve the Action Items for November 28, 2023; Approval of Operations & Finance item 1, seconded by Mr. Keeling and the motion was CARRIED in a roll call vote: Mr. Dumovic; yes, Mr. Keeling; yes, Dr. Mandel; yes, Mrs. Orban Brown; no, Mr. Christmann; yes, Mr. Dubeck; yes, and Mrs. Mody, yes – motion carries.

XIII. Discussion

Dr. Mandel - As the BOE delegate, I will be attending the NJSBA Delegate Assembly this weekend. There are 5 resolutions being considered - a 96-page document for review if you like - contact me if you have any questions.

Mr. Christmann - Observation (got snippy on one of the motions last week) - attending another governing body meeting recently and it was difficult to follow. "Too bad they don't run this meeting as if we are here - meaning the audience". I believe we should err on the side of making sure that the audience understands what we are doing because they don't understand the inside stuff. Continue to try to do better and make sure that the public has a good understanding of what we do.

Mrs. Orban Brown - I agree and I didn't catch the nuance of the motion, it was ok.

Mrs. Mody - Appreciate the effort of Mrs. Orban Brown to catch up and learn. As a board, we maintain a supportive environment. We can all keep learning about good meeting functioning
