IV. Sunshine Law

The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon. In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Mendham Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having date, time, and place thereof posted in the Mendham Township Board of Education Office, sent to the Clerk of Mendham Township, and the Observer Tribune and the Daily Record. This is an official meeting.

V. Superintendent's Report

Dr. Constantino reported to the Board on the following items:

- All monthly Emergency /Fire Drills were conducted in good fashion. The Mendham Township Police and Fire Departments were acknowledged for their assistance and cooperation.
- The elementary school will hosting the annual Festival of the Arts on May 25, 2017.
- School will be closed on Friday, May 26 as an unused snow day will be utilized.
- Current 4th graders will have the opportunity to participate in 5th grade transition activities on May 30 in preparation for their move to the middle school next year.
- The annual Minisink trip will take place on May 31.

- NJASK Science exams will be administered to 4th and 8th graders on May 31.
- The elementary school will present a Health and Wellness Fair on June 2.
- The annual Shakespeare Festival will also take place June 2.
- The annual "Lemon Ball" program will be held on June 9.
- The middle school graduation ceremony will be held on June 20 which is the final day of school.
- The "Coins for Kids" fund raiser for St. Peters' Orphanage in Denville will continue at the elementary school through May 25.
- The Board of Education self-evaluation and the annual CSA evaluation are both now available to Board members on the New Jersey School Boards Association website. These should be completed by June 10, 2017.
- The Board will be recognizing Ms. Cindy Scharf-Dour at the June Work Session meeting. Ms. Scharf-Dour will be retiring on June 30.
- The district's new website is being developed and is expected to be launched in early July.
- The Board will continue to schedule training sessions with the New Jersey School Boards Association to complete the process of completing certification. Mr. Kryger will coordinate the scheduling.

BOARD PRESENTATIONS:

Mr. Charles Gallo, MTES Technology teacher, made a presentation to the Board of Education on the MakerSpace program which he has been conducting for elementary school students. Mendham Township is one of the few elementary schools in New Jersey which offers this program. The program provides students with the opportunity to create, invent, explore and tinker with various projects while applying concepts involving technology, engineering and science. One recent project involved developing a method to drop an egg from 15 feet and not have the egg break. The program utilizes many donated items from the community in the design and completion of these projects. There are also assessment measures in place to evaluate student progress.

Ms. Sarah Bizzarro, MTES Art teacher, made a presentation to the Board of Education on the new Art Explorers program to be offered at the elementary school. This new program will offer interested students an opportunity to experience a higher level of appreciation of art than the Advanced Art Program. The program will also provide students an avenue to exhibit a higher level of their own artistic expression. Their exposure to and interaction with classical artists will also be enhanced through the new program. The program will also incorporate student assessments to evaluate progress throughout the year.

Mr. Brain Scharle, a representative from Source-4-Teachers made a presentation to the Board of Education on the merits of using his company's services to manage the district's task of procuring and scheduling substitute teachers and aides. Source-4-Teachers maintains a large pool of qualified personnel to provide these substitute services. The company would handle the assigning of substitutes to our district as well as processing of payroll for substitutes. Current substitutes working for the district would be retained, but would work with Source-4-Teachers

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for scheduling. The size of the district's substitute pool would also be enhanced as Source-4-Teachers draws personnel from a wider geographic area than the district currently employs.

VI. Board President's Report

VII. Correspondence

- Mr. Kryger updated information on the Direct Energy gas bill situation. Apparently, Direct Energy has been billing the Mendham Borough School District for one of the accounts that may belong to our district since 2010. Direct Energy has been asked to provide more solid substantiation that the account does in fact belong to Mendham Township.
- Mr. Kryger informed the Board that Nominating Petitions for the November 2017 School Board election are do not later than July 31, 2017. There will be two Board member positions to be filled.
- Mr. Kryger is waiting to hear from Mendham Township on suggested changes to the proposed Hold Harmless agreement related to the district's fuel storage tank at the Mendham Township Department of Public Works.

VIII. Committee Reports

> Curriculum and Instruction – Mr. Thayyar.

The committee discussed the suspension, truancy and emergency/fire drill reports for the month, the new Art Explorers program, two new novels to be incorporated into the sixth and seventh grade curriculum and the approval of a Strength and Conditioning physical education class for 2017-2018. Other discussion topics included the confirmation of previously approved field trips and chaperones, a request for mediation by the parents of a special need student and a status update on an existing HIB incident. The committee was also informed that presentations by Ms. Bizzarro (Art Explorers) and Mr. Gallo (MakerSpace) would be on the agenda for the Board's Work Session meeting.

> Operations and Finance – Mr. Kryger.

Committee discussion included the approval of the Board's meeting schedule through June 2018, the resolution for district tax collection for 2017-2018, agreements with the Morris County Ed Services Commission for transportation and professional support services, the 2017-2018 out of district tuition rates, transportation arrangements for Project Graduation (high school district) and Mendham Township Boy Scouts and the 2017-2018 lease agreement with Andrea Castiglione for before/after care at the elementary school. Finally, the committee reviewed the status of a health concern with a district bus driver and the Hold Harmless agreement with Mendham Township on the fuel storage tank located at the DPW.

The committee discussed the reappointment of MTEA Non-Certificated staff for 2017-2018, the approval of field trip chaperones, acceptance of a notice of staff retirement from Cynthia Scharf-Dour, substitute aide coverage for the Tiny Tiger program and an appointment to provider Home Instruction for one student. The committee also reviewed the possibility of engaging Source-4-Teachers to manage substitute personnel in the district, two new job descriptions (Lead Technician and Director of Human Resources), the Superintendent's contract and prospective changes in teaching staff for 2017-2018.
