IV. Sunshine Law

The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon. In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Mendham Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having date, time, and place thereof posted in the Mendham Township Board of Education Office, sent to the Clerk of Mendham Township, and the Observer Tribune and the Daily Record. This is an official meeting.

V. Superintendent's Report

Dr. Constantino reported to the Board of Education on the following items:

- Dr. Constantino will conduct the Superintendent's Fall Chat on Thursday, October 13, 2016. There will sessions at 9:00 am and 7:00 pm.
- All middle school sports teams have begun their fall competitions. Their full schedules are available on the district website.
- Presentations for the Superintendent's Tri-Annual report will be conducted by Dr. Ciccone, Ms. Kotcho and Mr. Koroski at the October Work Session.
- The Board will review annual goals for Principals and Administrators in October.
- Dr. Constantino reviewed the Board/Committee meeting schedule for October.

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- Mr. Kryger updated the Board on the status of the annual financial audit being conducted by Cannone & Company. Auditors have spent approximately four days in the district and have completed the majority of their on-site work. They may return in November if necessary and will submit their completed report by December 5, 2016 the statutory due date.
- QSAC information will be reviewed by the Board in November. This will be comprised of only desk audit information as the district will not have an on-site visit from the County Office of Education this year.
- Finally, Dr. Constantino reported that he will be travelling to Shanghai, China along with two other school superintendents from New Jersey to make a presentation on the oversight of education in the United States at the federal, state and local levels. The Board acknowledged Dr. Constantino for being selected to participate in this program.

Mendham Township Middle School Program Report

Dr. Patrick Ciccone, MTMS Principal, discussed the current scheduling of the middle school band practice and rehearsal sessions. He will be investigating possible changes to the schedule to perhaps reduce the number of weekly early morning (zero period) sessions.

Dr. Ciccone also presented to the Board of Education the details of a prospective new program at the middle school — "Not My Kid." The program would offer access to completely voluntary, random, anonymous and confidential drug testing for seventh and eighth grade students and families. The school district would not be involved in, have any knowledge of the results, or have any involvement with follow up on the testing. The district is only providing access to the program for interested families. Discussions will continue on this program.

Ms. deGrandpre encouraged Board members to consider attending the Morris County School Boards Association meeting being conducted in Mountain Lakes on September 28, 2016. The main topic of discussion will be school funding by the State of New Jersey.
