Hello Mendham Township Family,

I hope that this email finds your family well. I am so proud of the amazing efforts of our administration, teachers, and the entire staff in preparing for this week. Please see important information below, if you have any questions, please just let me know. Thank you and take care.

On Monday, March 16, our schools will be closed to students. The District will be using an emergency closing (snow day) to complete eLearning preparations and ensure families have all the resources necessary. Parents will be able to pick up technology or forgotten belongings between the hours of 7:00 am and 3:00 pm. Technology borrowing for all students (MS and ES) will be at the Elementary School from 7-9 am and 4-6 pm. Following those hours, schools will be locked and only accessible by District personnel.

Mendham Township Schools will be closed until at least April 6, 2020. We will follow the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), NJDOH, and NJDOE guidance regarding the timing of school opening and closing. This necessary action has been deemed the most effective way to disrupt widespread infection.

Our Distance Learning Program will begin on Tuesday, March 17. Instructions are available on each school website. Teachers will send instructions out to parents as well.
